Fiery Foods Show ready to heat up

The month of March is about to heat up.

The National Fiery Foods & Barbecue Show returns Friday through Sunday at Sandia Resort and Casino.

The trade show, which will feature about 250 vendors from more than 30 states and several countries, will be open to the public from 4-7 p.m. Friday, 11 a.m.-7 p.m. Saturday and 11 a.m.-6 p.m. Sunday, according to information from trade show representatives.

Admission for adults is \$10 in advance and \$5 for children to age 18 through Ticketmaster.com. At the door, adults will be charged \$15, children to age 18, \$5.

The show will feature new and, of course, hot foods, sweets, other products and even book signings.

Dave DeWitt, founder of the Fiery Foods show, will sign copies of his latest book, "The Complete Chile Pepper Book," at the booth for Los Ranchos-based LPD Press/Rio Grande Books, according to a news release from the publishing company.



DeWitt's co-author of "Chile Pepper Book" is Paul Bosland.

George Hensler also will sign copies of his book "Startin' the Fire," which details how to start a competition barbecue team. Hensler's signings will be at LPD Press's booth on Saturday at 10 a.m., noon, 2 p.m., 4 p.m. and 6 p.m.
